WHEREAS, on July 26, 2011, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance #85.00, creating the office of county accountant; and

WHEREAS, ORS 210.100 leaves the discretion of creating such office to the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the position of county accountant, which also served as the budget officer for Klamath County, has been vacant since October 17, 2017; and


WHEREAS, Local Oregon Budget Law requires the governing body to appoint a budget officer.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE KLAMATH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Ordinance #85.00, "Creating the Office of County Accountant" is hereby repealed in its entirety; and
2. The Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a qualified person as Klamath County Budget Officer; and
3. For the peace, health and safety of the people of Klamath County, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance is effective upon its passage.


